


# What is the current population of Croydon??




**% of population who are 0-17**



By 2031, this will increase by 14% to **444,573**




Croydon is the **19<sup>th</sup>** (out of 33)




In 2017/18, **5,562** people registered for National Insurance at a Croydon address whose previous address was overseas.....




People who registered for National Insurance number (NINO) in Croydon whose previous address was overseas (2017/18)

.....they have tended to move to Central or North East Croydon.....




.....nearly 1 in 4 of those were from Romania



People who registered for National Insurance number (NINO) in Croydon whose previous address was in Romania (2017/18)


High levels of new Romanian population in Ashburton West Ward










**Total Crime


