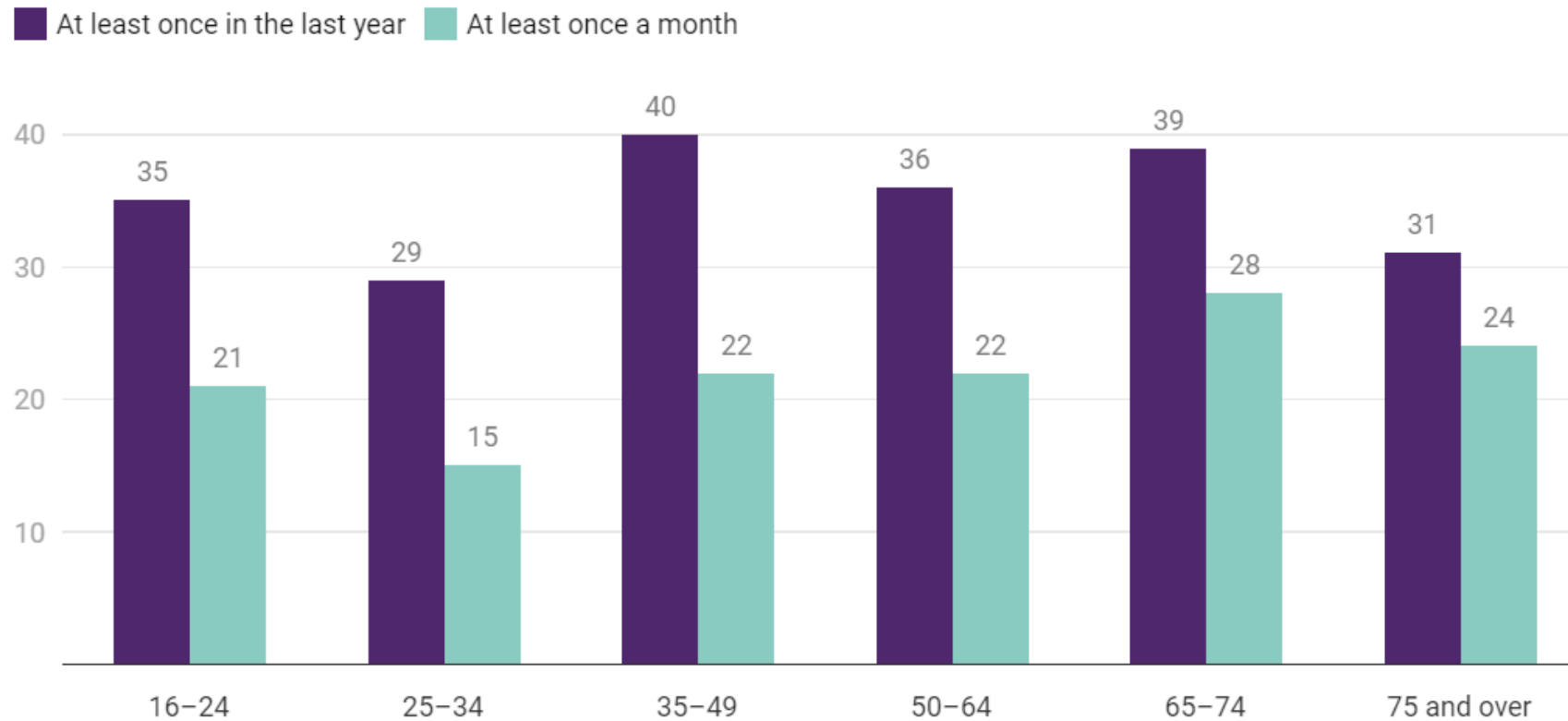


Why Datawrapper

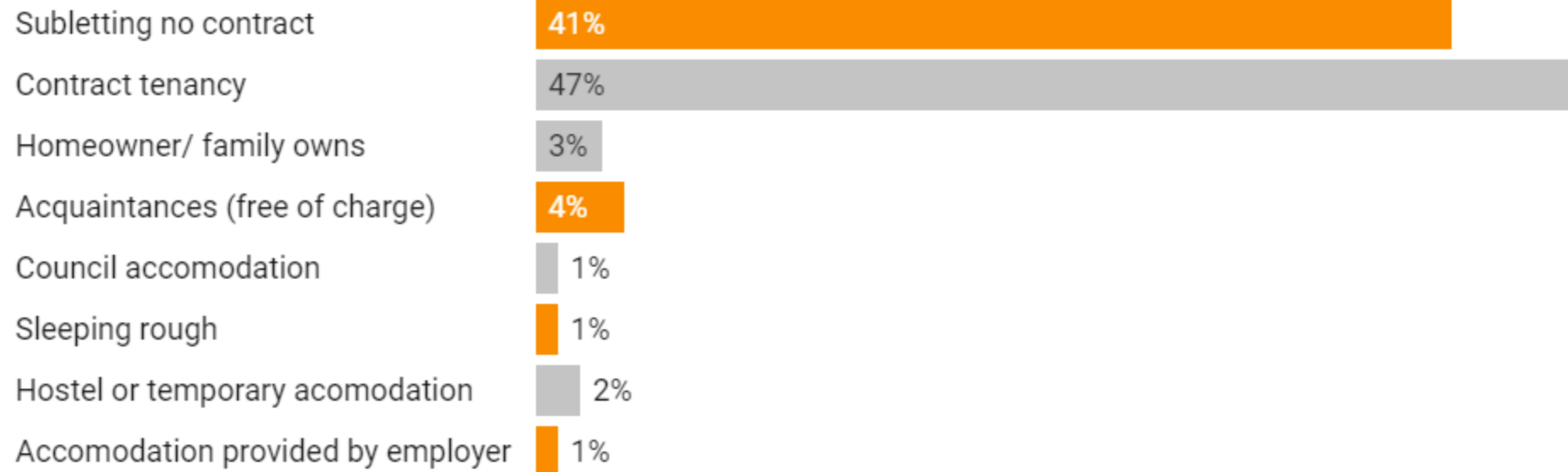
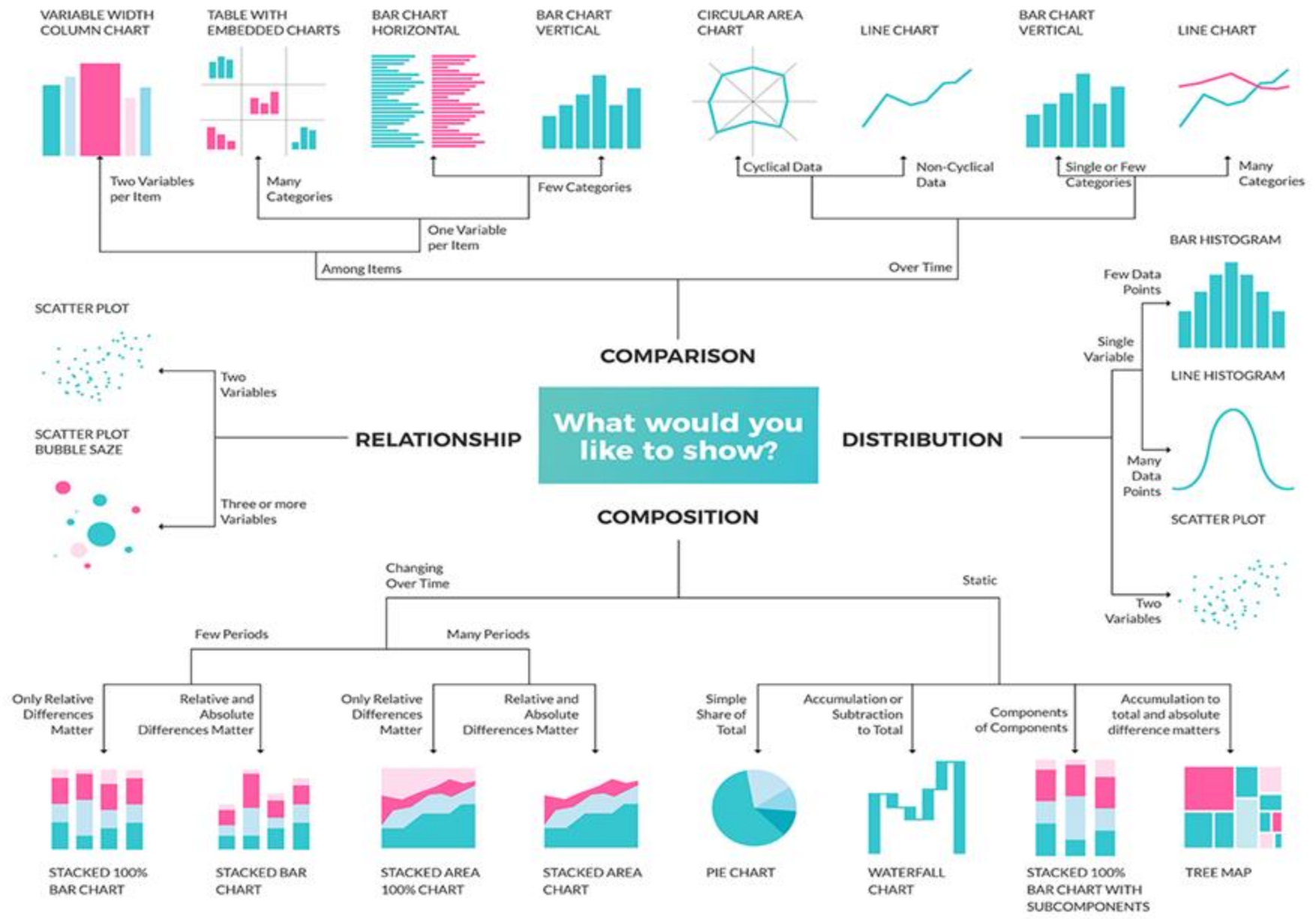
