How to Register with Charity Digital

- ✓ Provide some basic information about your charity
- ✓ Verify your charity status by uploading a copy of your registration document.
- ✓ Once registered, you can browse the catalogue of software products and apply for the ones that suit your needs



Funding tech

- Always build costs you can into projects / core funding (Full Cost Recovery and Unit Costs per worker as per your budget)
- Clothworkers Foundation capital funder. Apply for tech infrastructure e.g. laptops but also digital infrastructure including website & database costs (check eligibility)
- Look out for Funder Plus models e.g. City Bridge Foundation and Lloyds Bank Foundation which may cover costs e.g. database implementation




Some next steps

- Document User names, Passwords & Key email contacts for each item. Useful to have one place to refer to and to avoid issues when key staff leave




