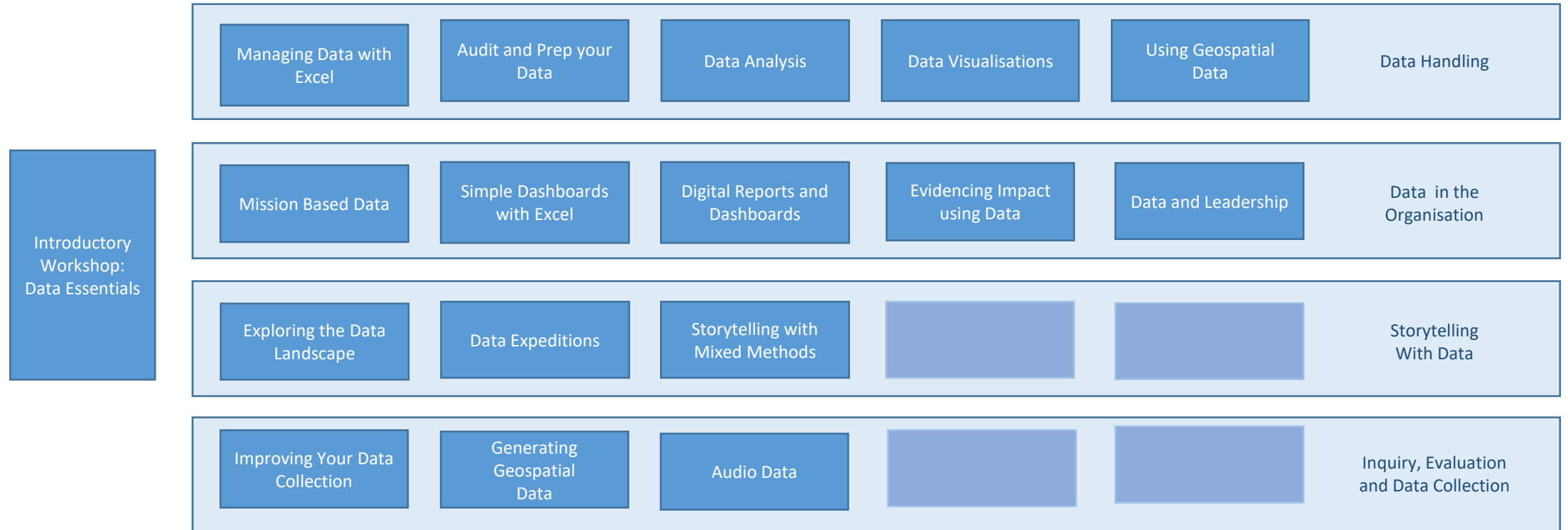

# Elements of the programme

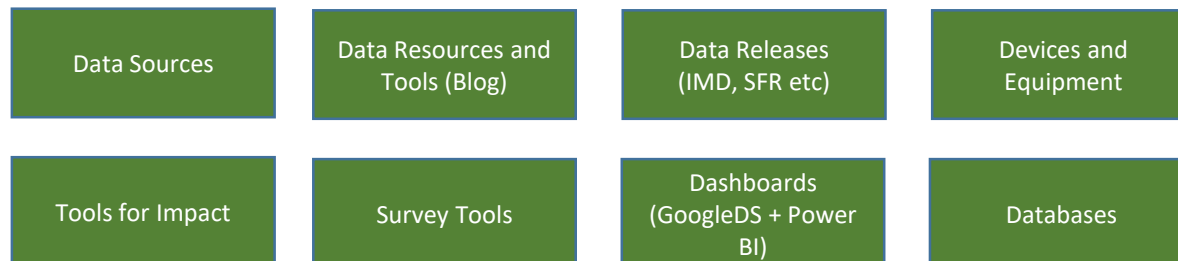
- A training programme building on the existing Superhighways offer
  - Moving from local data use (at Data Maturity Framework levels 1-2) to:
    - Integrating data practices into day to day working, planning, decision making
    - Identifying opportunities where data science tools and approaches are appropriate
    - Linking local data and practices to broader data landscapes
- Well documented teaching case studies of these at different scales
  - 4-6 case studies might include pan-London networks, borough-level initiatives, multi-agency working scenarios, working with (near) live data ...
- Developing and evaluating tools to address common use-cases e.g.
  - Mapping distribution of service users at LSOA / Ward / Borough level
  - Mapping cyclical patterns in need for services

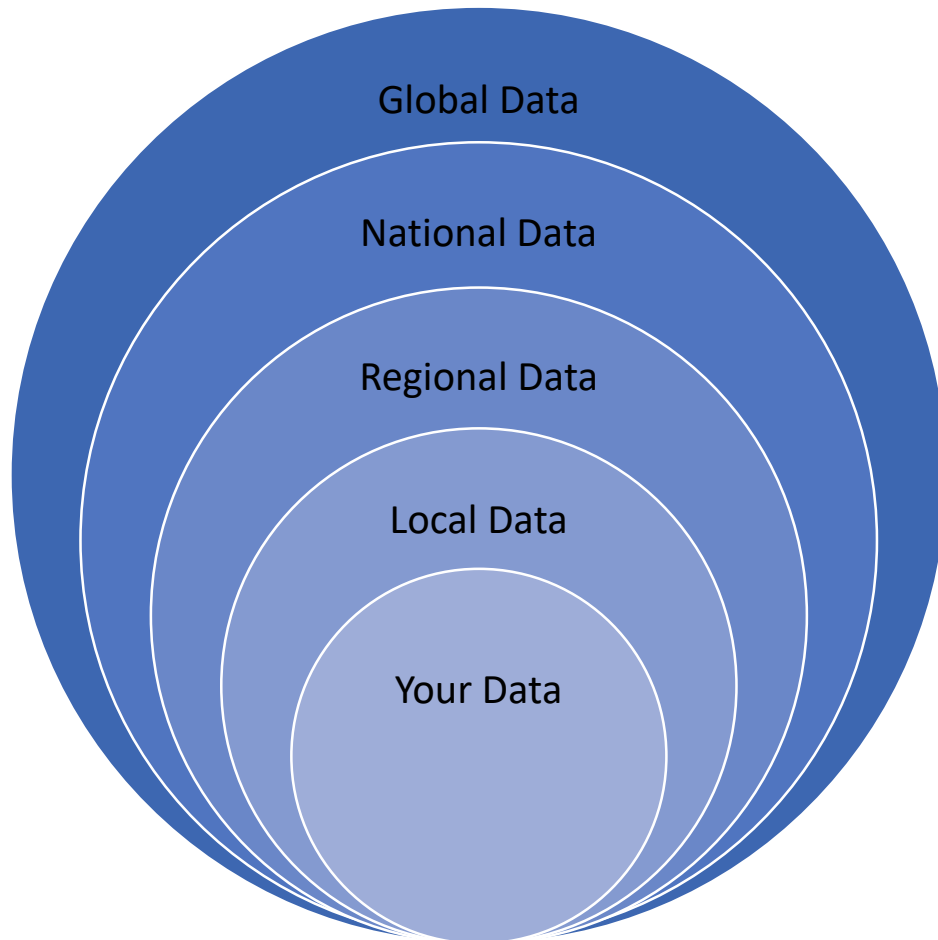
